## **Supplemental Report**

After receiving the CODIS Hit letter, Det. Bates looked up the last known address of James Beck – 45 Huntersville Court, Lillington, NC 27546. This residence was owned by Virginia Beck, who was the mother of the decedent. On April 20, 2019, Det. Bates went to the address to talk to Ms. Beck. Ms. Beck stated that she had not heard from her son, James Beck, in several months and they had a strained relationship. She said the last thing she knew was he was living with an individual by the name of "Mac." Det. Bates asked if Ms. Beck would consent to the collection of a DNA familial reference sample and she agreed.

On April 20th, a National Crime Information Center (NCIC) search for individuals with the alias "Mac" in the area turned up one result: Peter McHenry. Through an analytical search of open-sourced databases, Det. Bates found the following:

On social media, in the background of one of Peter's photos reportedly taken at his residence was an image of three blue 55-gallon drums and a piece of concrete. The photo was posted on March 3, 2019.
